Road Construction Notice:

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will resurface state route 65 in Salt Lake County from the Little Dell Reservoir Recreation Area (MP 3.1) to the Morgan County line at the Mormon Pioneer Trailhead (MP 8.4). Construction Impacts

Please be alert of temporary rumble strips and flaggers approaching the active work zone. Motorists should expect minor to moderate delays from 5-15 minutes. One lane in each direction will be maintained when crews are not working, including weekends.
