What is the MBAC PEDAL PASS?

The Mayor's Bicycle Advisory Committee (MBAC) Pedal Pass is the first year-round bicycle commuter advocacy program in Salt Lake City.

The Pedal Pass allows cyclists to receive discounts or other rewards for their commitment to clean air and alternative transportation to lessen congestion, parking hassle, and fossil fuel consumption. It is also intended to increase safety for cyclists by increasing the number of bikes on the roads.
